2. Ace's Frustration!

Ace gets fed up with everyone telling him how to handle his bleed and prophy regimen, which leads him to retreating into the storage closet.

Can you relate to Ace's frustration? Have you ever felt ignored, dismissed, or badgered when discussing your own self-care with doctors and/or family?
How could Dr. Young and the gang have better explained the importance of maintaining a prophy regimen to Ace?
Ace, in a moment of anger, claims to not need a "nurse or babysitter" - have there been times where you felt the way Ace does in that moment? If so, why?

3. Adam's Story

Spencer tells Ace the story of his younger brother, Adam, who also stopped infusing prophylactically and ended up passing away from a head bleed while in college.. The powerful, personal story helps Ace understand the importance of self-care and having a consistent prophy regimen.
